A LOCAL cleaning company is to continue its association with The Open golf championships after it was re-awarded the contract to clean for one of the world's biggest marketing groups at the event.

Feather Flickers, which is based in Tarleton, had a contract with IMG (International Management

Group) at The Open at Royal Birkdale in 2008 and Turnberry in 2009 and will again work for IMG at this year's tournament in St Andrews in July.

Greg Gottig from the company said a team of eight people will be leaving the offices of Feather Flickers on Saturday, July 11 to embark on a contract worth "many thousands of pounds."

They will also be working at two other IMG bases and more than 20 residential

properties being rented by some of the best known golfers in the world.

The main base is being used to host golfers during the tournament and to provide for their every need – from managing their tee off times to catering for them.

Mr Gottig, added: "It is very exciting to be part of The Open championships again and I'm looking forward to serving IMG at St Andrews, which is the finest golf destination in the world."
